- 1 (a) At 9 September 2024, the sum of £6,397.50 has been received from Rotarians on account of their future dining costs. At that date, some Rotarians owe a total of £500.70 for meals that they have taken but not yet paid for which leaves a net sum of £5,896.80 as repayable to Rotarians and that is accrued above. The cost of meals for the speakers and or certain guests nominated by the President are to be charged against the Dining General Fund. A surplus of £203.00 is shown above on the 2024/25 Dining fund for the year to date.
- 1 (b) The cost of the meal taken at the K&C Club on 6 August is expected to amount to £440.00 and that taken on 3 September is expected to amount to £540.00. These sums are accrued above pending receipt of the invoices. The total cost of the Bat and Trap Event was £765.00 and Canterbury FoB Rotary Club and RCC, Sunrise have paid their share of this cost.
